JULIAN SAS album MILES AND MEMORIES

marks the guitar hero's return to his favorite band lineup – the classic blues-rock trio – vocals/guitar, bass, and drums. In this case, the emphasis lies a bit more on the rock and a fraction less on the blues.

Julian Sas: Looking back on 32 years of my life on the road; jamming and making music,'a new three-piece band, different influences, new boundaries to cross and truly free while playing.....

We returned to a classic blues-rock trio. Just like I started years ago. It felt like coming home. The energy, the rock & roll, the blues. It drips off it. Being a non-commercial BLUES-ROCK band for 32 years makes me proud! We often stood at the crossroads, but never sold our souls. And we never do. We don't have to... we don't want to... the only thing that matters and still matters is the music! Nothing else matters...!

It was late 1994 when the young Julian Sas formed his own band, briefly making a name for himself as a must-see live act and one of Europe's best Blues Rock Guitarists. Now, 32 years later, Julian Sas is an established name and an admired guitar hero with a large following of dedicated fans all over the world. From the Benelux to the United States, from Germany to Brazil and beyond.
